The Challenge

On average, up to 80% of gun violence [↗] goes unreported to 9-1-1. As a result, eight out of ten times when someone fires a gun, the police never show up, simply because they don't know about it. When gun crime and other crime isn't reported, perpetrators grow emboldened, putting everyone else in the community at risk.

Our Mission

Our mission is to reduce crime by partnering with community violence intervention (CVI) groups and other local organizations. By sharing precise data on when and where gun violence and other crimes occur, we help these groups respond quickly, so that they can provide critical support to youth and families in crisis and prevent future harm.

Our team brings decades of experience in community advocacy, government affairs, generalist social work practice, and law enforcement. We believe collaboration is key—and together, we can drive meaningful, lasting change.

Data for Good – Assisting Community Violence Intervention and Public Health Groups

SoundThinking's Data for Good Program enables law enforcement to share gunfire and crime data with community partners, helping identify areas impacted by violence so resources can be deployed quickly to support residents and address root causes.

Walking One Stop, Miami-Dade County, FL

SoundThinking partners with Walking One Stop [↗] to deliver gunfire data in Miami-Dade County, helping the organization target areas most affected by gun and gang violence. From 2018 to 2020, Walking One Stop provided nearly 3,000 service referrals—most within a week of initial contact. More than 20 elected officials, researchers, and advocates have joined community walks to hear directly from families about needed policies and interventions. [↗]

Here are examples of some cities we partner with through our Data for Good program.



San Francisco, CA

SoundThinking's Data for Good program helps the San Francisco Police Department and its civic partners convene community roundtables, share dashboard insights, and organize neighborhood ride-alongs. Through monthly meetings with clergy, violence intervention groups, and local businesses, the team utilizes real gunfire data to inform outreach and prevention efforts.

Springfield, IL

Springfield uses ShotSpotter data to identify where to host its Community Connect meetings — events designed to deliver social, health, and economic resources directly to residents who need them most. By pinpointing neighborhoods most affected by gun violence, the city ensures that outreach efforts are data-driven and equitable. These gatherings bring together local agencies, nonprofits, and residents to foster trust, share information, and promote long-term community resilience.



Miami-Dade, FL and Bladensburg, MD
